Door to Door Waste collection



From 1st April 2019 onwards the 9 member Nirmal brigade started their work in Sennakuppam and Oragadam Villages. The Awareness Programmes conducted among the Villages made more people to participate in our Programme. Mass cleaning of the accumulated garbage in all the streets were cleared using Panchayth Tractor once in a Week basis. Door to door waste collection happened on daily basis. 1057 House holds including Migrants got benefitted.



Yard Kitchen Garden

The Gardner for Sennakuppam maintained Kitchen Garden in our Waste Segregation shed, one kitchen Garden Near Oragadam Panhayath Office. The Vegetables are sold to the beneficiaries for nominal Price.



One new Tricycle was inducted in to service this year .Tricycles are maintained Properly



All the Nirmal Brigade Members were provided with Uniforms ,Caps ,Masks and hand gloves on regular basis.

Awareness Programme for the Villagers

It is planned to create awareness among the Villagers about the benefits of having a KICHEN GARDEN at their back yard with a Manure Pit . The idea behind is to make use of the wet waste generated at source.



To implement the KITCHEN GARDEN Plan, Mrs.Lakshmi was appointed as Awareness Coordinator with a responsibility of Creating awareness among the beneficiaries about KITCHEN GARDEN at their Homes and to identify 100 willing beneficiaries. Out of the planned 100 we have achieved 90 KITCHEN GARDENS with our Gardner.



Thus Wet waste coming out has been stopped to the maximum extend in 90 House holds.
