SANITATION PROJECT

Sanitation Project with 'To make villages Open Defecation Free ' as Main Goal and with a objective of providing maximum coverage of Individual House Hold Toilets in Valayakkarani , Nattarasanpattu Panchayaths & Mathur was implemented during this FY 2019-20.

Outputs/outcomes/impact

- 122 Individual House Hold bathing cum toilets constructed
- Nearly 477 members got toilet facility.
- 11 awareness programs conducted
- 3399 members covered under awareness programs
- More than 95% constructed toilets are used for defecation & bathing
- 122 Individual House Hold toilets having proper facility of waste water outlet
- 100% community contribution of INR 5,000/ from 110 house hold
- 12 Toilets constructed under Employee Sponsorship.

Construction of Toilets



Under Sanitation Project We have constructed 122 toilets with bathing and drain water facility with beneficiary contribution of 5000 in Nattarasanpattu, Valayakkaranaï and Mathur GPs



About 12 Toilets were sponsored by Apollo Tyres Employees by paying beneficiary contribution of Rs.5000 to the eligible ST families and for disabled person's family.

On 19th November 2019 , WORLD TOILET BDAY was celebrated in Nattarasanpattu Gram Panchayath. All the beneficiaries and in students from Nattarasanpattu High School , Nattarasanpattu Primary School, and Umayal Baranichery High School took active participation. Painting Competition, Toilet Slogan Competition and Clean Toilet Completion were conducted and Prizes distributed to the winners .



Activities undertaken

1. Balloon Awareness: Helium Balloon with Apollo Logo were tied in all the constructed toilets
2. Video coverage of all the Toilets aerial View with Drone.
3. In all the 4 Schools in both Valayakkarani , Nattarasanpattu Panchayaths Dummy Toilet models were kept and children were encouraged to write how important is toilet to them.
- 4 '10 reasons they are happy having toilet ' poster competition conducted in all 4 Schools.
5. Competition for keeping the Toilet Clean among the beneficiaries conducted and Toilet Cleaning Kits were given as Gifts.
6. WTD Celebration was Organized near Nattarasanpattu PHC. Nearly 170 Beneficiaries and School Students participated.
7. Sanitation Awareness Short films and Documentaries were Screened.
8. All the participants were given Tea, snacks and Lunch Pack.
